




How does this link to/ build on previous learning?

Vocabulary

continent	large areas of land often separated by oceans
equator	an imaginary circle around the centre of the Earth
Northern Hemisphere	the half of the Earth that is north of the Equator
Southern Hemisphere	the half of the Earth that is south of the Equator
population	the number of people living in an area
weather	the day to day changes that we see happen
climate	the average weather usually taken over 30 years for a particular place
tropical	Around the Equator, we have tropical climates, which are hot and humid.
temperate	areas where summers are mild and winters aren't too cold – like the UK
habitat	the home of an animal or plant
aerial view	the view of something from directly above
