
### Please find below some step-by-step instructions for using Spelling Frame.


- 1. Go to the Spelling Frame website: <a href="https://spellingframe.co.uk/">https://spellingframe.co.uk/</a>
- 2. Click log in and type in your child's log in details.



3. You will be taken to the dashboard. Here your child can see their spelling points and their latest test results (for tests taken at home online), as well as access their spellings for the next week. Our school has not opted to use the spelling points function at this time, as we like to celebrate effort over accuracy!



4. Click 'Go To Test'. This will not take the child to *just* their test. It will take them to their spelling rule games and an <u>optional</u> test.



5. Here your child can access a range of games and resources to help them to revise their spellings. Unless your teacher specifies otherwise, your child can revise using any (or none) of these games.

# **Spelling Tiles**

### **Practice / Test**

Watch and listen as each word in the list is broken into either syllables or phonemes and sounded out.

Choose from a range of activities to help you learn the spelling of your chosen words.

Choose to practise spelling the words on your list or take a test with them. If you choose to take a test, your scores will be recorded and sent to your teacher (if you are logged in) or they can be downloaded and printed.

#### **Play Games**

You can play any of the games below. If you choose 'Test Mode' in a game, your score will be saved and sent to your teacher. Your score will not be saved if you choose 'Practice Mode' but you will get Spelling Points.







6. There is the option for your child to complete an online test. Completing these online tests weekly helps enables Spelling Frame to tailor to your child's profile. Every time your child spells incorrectly in the test, the word is added to their list of 'Tricky Words'. They can return to their 'Tricky Word' list any time and revise the words which caught them out in previous spelling rules. I highly recommend that you encourage your child to use this feature, but it is not compulsory.


7. If you want your child's mistakes to be recorded to their Tricky Words list, then they must click 'Begin Test' not 'Begin Practice'.

Listen to the words and check the sentences for meaning.



8. After doing a test, your child can return to the dashboard and practise their tricky words at any time.

Your child's log-in gives them access to all spelling rules for all year groups from the home page – great for revising or getting ahead!
