

Brentry Primary School  
Parent Survey 2025/26



We have chosen to represent the results in a couple of different ways this year:

- Firstly, we have shown the number of people who selected each grade per statement as a % in the appropriate column. 86 surveys were completed, but one or two people didn't tick all boxes. A few people put ticks in between boxes. Where this has happened, we have counted it as the most negative out of the two choices. For example, if the tick was between Agree and Disagree, we have counted it as Disagree.
- Secondly, we have formulated an '**Average Score**' score for each statement, which allows us to rank them in terms of parental preference. This is based on Strongly Agree being worth 4, down to Strongly Disagree being worth 1. We have removed the Don't Knows from this scoring. Then we multiplied the number of ticks by the appropriate number, added up the total and divided by how many people responded to that statement. The max score is thus 4. **Best Scores** **Lowest Scores**

**NB** It should be pointed out that where 'Don't Know' was ticked on certain questions, this was largely by Reception parents who felt they could not answer with any confidence/knowledge as yet, or in the case of statements 6 and 8, those parents who had not come across the issue in order to have an opinion.

#### Key findings:

- The areas that parents appear most happy about are pupil care, safety, teaching and the leadership of the school.
- Whilst acknowledging that all of the average scores are high, and largely positive, the areas where parents are least happy are homework, information about progress and information about the role of the *Governing* Body and how to contact it.
- 100% of people who responded agree that their child is well looked after and that they are taught well. 100% said they would recommend the school to another parent (apart from one Reception parent who 'didn't know', as their child had only just started)
- 5% of responders said that their child wasn't happy at the school. Whilst a very small percentage, it is too high for our liking, and we have taken note of the comments made in order to look to address this.
- There were lots of comments made. The majority were positive, which we appreciate, but there were several comments made which were constructively critical, and which we very much appreciate too. These were largely to do with communication, but there were also comments made about things like the behaviour of a small minority of pupils, the amount of homework given, school trips and the role of governors. We will be actively working to respond to the main themes of criticism.
